

FULTON COUNTY PORK PRODUCERS AGRICULTURAL SCHOLARSHIP

Due date April 11, 2024.

The Fulton County Pork Producers award these scholarships to recognize dedication and commitment to agriculture. The need for well educated, talented men and women to meet the demand for increasingly complex agri-business operations continues to grow. Therefore, the recipient will demonstrate dedication to the agricultural industry with plans to make a significant contribution to the industry upon completion of his/her education.

Scholarships to be given as follows:

Two \$500 scholarships for a 4 year course of study, or a
2 year associate degree in an agriculture related field

Criteria for eligibility

A. The applicant must:

1. Be a resident of Fulton County, IN
2. Be enrolled or accepted at an accredited college or university pursuing a career in an agriculture related field.
3. Students that have been active in the 4-H swine project who are not going into an Ag. field also qualify
4. Must not have received this scholarship previously.

B. The \$500 scholarship will be paid directly to the winners in the summer following successful completion of 2 semesters or 3 quarters.

At that time the student will be:

1. Be classified as a sophomore, junior, or senior at his/her institution.
2. Be a full time student, based on his/her institution's criteria for such and possess a minimum cumulative graduation index of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (C+ average) based on work from at least 2 semesters or 3 quarters.

C. The applicant must submit:

1. A completed application form by April 12th, 2024.
2. An essay of 250 words or less telling how he/she plans to make a significant contribution to agriculture to agriculture.
3. Transcript of high school or college grades.
4. Estimated academic expenses.

Selection for the Fulton County Pork Producers' Agricultural Scholarship will be considered on the basis of the applicants commitment to agriculture, financial need, leadership activities and academic merit.

The recipient will be notified at the awards night at their high school.
