Eligibility Requirements:

The applicant must be a senior living in Fulton County.

Application Procedure:

The applicant must submit a packet assembled and consisting of a completed scholarship application form and the following attachments:

- 1. Resume containing all school activities, offices that the student has participated in, accomplishments, and honors;
- 2. A current photograph;
- 3. A statement explaining what community service means to you and detailing your involvement in community service projects and activities;
- 4. Three letters of recommendation from adults not related to the applicant; and
- 5. An original academic transcript with current grade point average.
